Mission Trip to Hungary and Ukraine, September 20 to October 5

Would you like to go with Rev. Bob Bailey and Rev. Cliff Cain to Hungary and Ukraine from Tuesday, September 20 to Wednesday, October 5? In Hungary you will meet with Bishop Csomos and our Hungarian friends who visited us this spring. You will see their work in churches, missions and schools. Schools will be in session, so you will meet the young students. In Ukraine you will meet Rev. David Pandy-Szekeres, and see his work in schools and his outreach to the Roma (gypsies).

Bob Bailey (a semi-retired professor and pastor, most recently at Bethel-Salem Church near Morrison) and Cliff Cain (a professor at Westminster) would be happy to take with them 4 or 5 fellow travelers from churches in our Missouri Union Presbytery. It is not a commercial tour, arrangements will be made individually, so costs and flights are uncertain, but airfare will cost roughly \$1,000, plus maybe \$200 or so for a few meals, souvenirs and miscellaneous.



Deadline for reservations is August 20. Time is short, and airline tickets may sell out, so move quickly if you want to go. Make sure you have a currently valid passport, then call or email Bob Bailey in (573)634-8660 or bobannell@embarkmail.com.
